Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, our performance at The Queen Katharine Academy is fast approaching (**Wednesday 28th March**) and so it is time to think about costumes for the performance. We have tried to keep it as simple as possible as some of the pupils will be requiring additional items due to performing as part of the class and in the acting section. Where possible, the outfits will be the same or very similar, with only slight changes having to be completed on the night, but there have been a few instances where this has not been possible.

If your child is acting, please follow the guidance under the acting section as this will also cover what they need to wear for the dance. If your child is not involved in the acting, please just follow the dance section. Your child should know which of the following applies to them, but if unsure, please speak to a member of the Year 6 team or Miss Hodgkins.

Year 6 Acting:

Narrators – All in Black, such as a black dress or top and black skirt or trousers.

White Witch – All in white, such as a dress or leggings/a skirt with a white top.

Mr Tumnus – A beige top (skin coloured) and brown or black trousers/ shorts. If possible, a red scarf.

Lucy and Susan – A colourful dress- would advise shorts or leggings underneath.

Peter and Edmund – Trousers or shorts (but not jeans or tracksuit bottoms please) and a colourful top.

Aslan – Brown/ yellow (lion colours). If possible, an additional colourful top as this will be worn for the first part of the dance. A mask will be made in school and taken to the performance.

Conductor/Announcer – Black trousers such as school trousers and a blue top/shirt. If owned a blue jacket and a blue cap but this is not vital. A cap may be sourced if needed.

Dwarf – All in Black, such as black school trousers and a black top. Please no jeans or tracksuit bottoms to be worn.

Mum – A black top with jeans and an optional colourful cardigan. (Would advise black leggings to be worn under the jeans and can then easily be changed for the dance).

Oreius – Trousers or shorts (but no jeans or tracksuit bottoms please) and a colourful top.

White Witch followers – All in Black, such as a black dress or top and black skirt or trousers.

Year 6 Dance:

White Witch – All in white, such as leggings or skirt with a white top of a dress. (Same outfit as worn for the acting).

Bad side – To be dressed all in black. This could consist of trousers, shorts, skirts, dresses and a top.

Good side – Something colourful. This could consist of trousers, shorts, skirts, dresses and a top.

Please can all pupils wear trainers and as per the school PE policy and long hair should be tied up and out the way. Please can all outfits be brought into school by **Wednesday 21st March** in order to check that every pupil has a costume to wear. This will then be sent home again and should be worn to the performance on the evening of **Wednesday 28th March**.

If you have any questions regarding the outfit for your child or any help sourcing a costume please speak to a member of the Year 6 team.
