

Dear parents and carers of children in **Years 5 and 6**

Bikeability Plus Surveys

As you may already be aware, Bikeability cycle training is delivered at our school. This year our school is also participating in a range of additional 'Bikeability Plus' activities supported by Transport for London (TfL). Our school is collecting monitoring data so TfL can evaluate the success of the project.

Over the coming weeks, we will be running a 10-minute online survey during class time for all pupils in **Years 5 and 6**. The survey will be repeated again in June/July and will provide evidence to determine what difference Bikeability Plus makes to children's cycling.

I am writing to ask for your consent for your child to undertake the survey.

The survey asks children about how they travel to school and to other places nearby. It also asks for their date of birth, school year and gender so their responses to both surveys can be matched. Research shows that age and gender do influence travel behaviour, so it is important that these questions are included.

All children's answers will remain confidential and anonymous. It will not be possible for any child to be identified individually in the data or reports. Children are told not to include their name in the survey.

The survey will be administered during class time by teachers at school. It is being organised on behalf of TfL by the Bikeability Support Team at transport consultants Steer Davies Gleave, who are registered with the Information Commissioner's Office and follow strict data management protocols in accordance with the Data Protection Act.

We have been promised a data report based on our pupils' survey responses. This will provide an exciting learning resource for the KS2 Maths curriculum, and will also be used to inform our school travel plan and promote more active travel to school.

I hope you agree that participation in the Bikeability Plus survey will be beneficial. However, if for any reason you do not wish your child to participate, you may return the opt-out slip below via the school office by **Monday 18th April 2016**.
