Dear Parents/Carers,

As a school we are going to be holding our very own Race for Life on **Thursday 13th July 2017**. Throughout the course of the day all pupils will take part in the event in order to raise money for Cancer Research UK. Pupils have each been given a blank sponsorship form to take home and collect sponsors. Every contribution, no matter how big or small, is one step closer to beating Cancer and as a school we would like to do our bit to support such a wonderful cause. If the individual sponsoring the pupil is a UK tax payer, please encourage them to tick the gift aid box on the form. This will increase their donation by 25% at no extra cost to the individual. Sponsor money will then be due in by no later than the 19th July 2017, therefore giving us time to calculate the total amount raised before the end of the school year. All money will then be sent on together.

EYFS and KS1 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) and KS2 (Year 3, 4, 5 and 6) will complete the run separately with EYFS/KS1 going onto the field during the morning at approximately 9:15am and KS2 following suit in the afternoon, starting at approximately 1:30pm. EYFS/KS1 will be encouraged to complete up to 5 laps of the field, which is equal to 2.5km, whereas KS2 will aim to complete up to a full 5k circuit. All pupils who take part in the event will receive a medal for participation.
