Absence Reporting

If your child is unwell and unable to attend school on the first day of absence contact the school office on 574717 **by 8.45am**. If no-one is available please leave a message.

Should the school office not receive a reason for absence on the first day, they will endeavour to contact parents/carers to check the safety of the child. As part of our Safeguarding procedures, if the school is unable to make contact with parent/carer or other emergency contact, a safe and well check will be carried out by school and/or police.

Sickness/Diarrhoea

Please remember that if your child has sickness or diarrhoea they must be kept off school for a **minimum of 48 hours** from the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting. This is to reduce the risk of infection to other children and adults in school.


Attendance

Norwood Primary School aims to work together with our parents/carers to ensure that all children registered at the school attend both regularly and punctually. We value every child as an individual and believe that every child has an entitlement to education, enabling them to achieve their full potential.


Penalty Notices are issued by Peterborough Local Authority for the following;

- The pupil attendance levels falls to 90% or below and at least 8 sessions of unauthorised absence within an 8 week period (up to 3 penalty notices may be issued in any academic year).
- Persistent late arrival at school after the register has closed contributing to a level of 90% or below.
- Leave of absence in term time which has not been authorised by the school.
- Not remaining within the dates agreed for any authorised leave of absence.

Norwood Primary School has a Governor Attendance Panel and any absences that are not exceptional circumstance/unavoidable will be unauthorised.



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At Norwood we monitor attendance and late arrivals of our pupils and work very closely with our Local Authority Attendance Officer. We will make contact with parents/carers by letter if we are concerned about either lateness or poor attendance. If poor attendance/lateness continues this could instigate involvement of the Local Authority Attendance Officer in requesting a meeting to discuss the concerns.
