

Just to inform parents/carers of our policy regarding snacks:

- Children in Reception have access to the snack table throughout the day.
- At morning break time KS1 pupils will be offered a free piece of fruit or veg as provided by the SFVS Scheme, or allowed to eat one they have bought from home.
- KS2 pupils will be encouraged to bring a piece of fresh/dried fruit/vegetables for their mid-morning

snack. Alternative snacks are not allowed.
