Dear Parents/Carers,

At Norwood we will be running a variety of after school clubs starting on **Week beginning 27th February 2017**. The final session for these clubs will be during the week beginning **3rd April 2017**.

After gathering some feedback from children, we have aimed to provide a mix of clubs that require payment and those that are free of charge. We have also aimed to ensure that there is a club for each age group, each day of the week to cover a variety of interests. Where possible, we have altered the age range that clubs are open to this coming half term to ensure that all children have the opportunity to take part. We hope that your child can find a club that excites them enough to take part!

All clubs (unless otherwise indicated) will begin at 3:15pm and end at 4:15pm. Children will be dismissed from the indicated entrance by the group leader. Below is a list of the clubs on offer this term and the day they will take place each week.

Monday

- ***Handball (Rec, 1 and 2) - Youth Dreams Project £3.00 per session (£18 to ParentPay)**
Handball is a team sport in which two teams of seven players each pass a ball using their hands with the aim of throwing it into the goal of the other team. This is an indoor club. Children will need a sports kit to change into. Children will be dismissed from the hall door to the main playground.
- ***Goalkeeping club (Years 3, 4, 5, 6)- A Sporting Hand £3.00 per session (£18 to A Sporting Hand)**
Goalkeeping club aims to develop the skills of budding goal keepers. This is an outdoor club. Children need warm clothes and trainers. They will be on the field and involved in diving for the ball at times, so may come home muddy! Children will be dismissed from the main office.

Tuesday

- ***Gymnastics (Year 3, 4, 5, 6)- Youth Dreams Project £3.00 per session (£18 to ParentPay)**
Gymnastics club will focus on developing children's balance and co-ordination, with some use of apparatus. Children will need shorts and a t-shirt to change into for this club. No leggings, please as the children need to be able to grip the wall bars. Children will be dismissed from the hall door to the main playground.
- ***Goalkeeping club (Years R, 1, 2)- A Sporting Hand £3.00 per session (£18 to A Sporting Hand)**
Goalkeeping club aims to develop the skills of budding goal keepers. This is an outdoor club. Children need warm clothes and trainers. They will be on the field and involved in diving for the ball at times, so may come home muddy! Children will be dismissed from the main office.
- **Construction club (Years 1 and 2)- Miss N Butler Free of charge**
Come and build, and create whatever you want with Lego, blocks, Knex and much, much more!
Children will be dismissed from the Year 1 classroom door.

Wednesday

- **Newspaper club at Lunchtime (Years 2, 3, 4, 5, 6)- Mrs J Cockerill Free of charge**
Would you like to be the journalists for the first Norwood Newspaper? If you enjoy writing, taking photographs, interviewing and finding out about school events, then this club could be for you.

- **Football (Years 4, 5, 6)**-Mr S Johnson **Free of charge**
Football club is aimed at children who are at a competitive level and prepares them to compete in inter-school competitions. This is an outdoor club. Children need warm clothes and football boots.
Children will be dismissed from the field.
- ***Robotics (Years 3, 4, 5, 6)** This club is already fully booked.
Children will be dismissed from the main office.
- ***Art club (Reception and Year 1)**-Mrs Godden **£3.00 per session (£18 to ParentPay) This club finishes at 4.30pm.**
Over the course of six weeks, children will create a variety of Art projects to bring home, developing a variety of skills led by our very own artist, Mrs Godden. Children will be dismissed from the art area door onto the small playground.
- ***Feeder Soccer (Reception-Year 1)** - Mr E Parry. Please email FeederSoccer@aol.com regarding spaces and cost of this club.

Thursday

- ***Multi-Skills (Rec, 1, 2)**- Youth Dreams Project **£3.00 per session (£18 to ParentPay)**
During these sessions, children will develop skills of balance, their control of small and large movements, encourage healthy competition and team work. This is an indoor club. Children will need a change of clothes e.g. t-shirt plus shorts/ tracksuit bottoms.
Children will be dismissed from the hall door to the main playground.
- **Science Experiment club (Years 3, 4, 5, 6)**- Mr K Burnham **Free of charge**
Do you love to experiment with materials and find out what might happen? Then this club could be for you! Mr Burnham will help you to set up experiments, record the data and find answers to many scientific questions.
Children will be dismissed from the Year 3 classroom door.
- **Origami club (Years 3, 4, 5, 6)**- Miss M Hodgkins **Free of charge**
Come along and learn the art of origami; making creations from folding paper.
Children will be dismissed from the Year 5 classroom door.
- **Recorder club (Years 2 and 3)**- Mr J Saunders **Free of charge**
This club is for children who would like to start to learn to play the recorder. It is a beginners club in which children will learn how to read music and play a variety of tunes. There is no requirement for children to bring their own recorder. Children will be dismissed from the Year 2 classroom door.

Friday

- ***Feeder Soccer (Years 2 & 3)** - Mr E Parry. Please email FeederSoccer@aol.com regarding spaces and cost of this club.
- ***First Aid (Years 5 and 6)**- Mrs R O'Brien **£3.50 per session (£21 to ParentPay)**
Mrs O'Brien trains Norwood adults to administer first aid. She would like to help our children to understand how they can help others in need, in a safe way. Initially the club is open to Y5 & 6. If it is popular, we will open it to other year groups in the Summer term. Children will be dismissed from the main office.
- **Peterborough United Girls Football (Years 4, 5, 6)**- Miss M Stickland **Free of charge**
Miss Stickland is a community coach for PUFC. There is a **free taster session** on Friday 3rd March followed by **6 week free football training for girls**. We are one of only two schools selected for this opportunity for the whole of Peterborough Primary Schools! The club will be based outdoors. Children will need warm sports kit and football boots/trainers. Children will be dismissed from the field.

***These clubs are available free of charge to pupils in receipt of the Pupil Premium funding. This may apply if your child has free school meals now or in the past. If you are unsure if your child is eligible, please contact the school office.**

Full payment (cost per week x 6) will be required by 27th February. Please pay on ParentPay. Please only pay when you have received an email to say your child has been allocated a place. There is maximum numbers for each club, if you child is not successful in a club we will put their name on a waiting list.

Should your child wish to attend more than one club (on different days) then please underline the club(s) on the reply slip below and return this to school by **Tuesday 14th February 2017**. You will be informed of which club(s) your child has a place within by email on Friday 17th February 2017.
