#### **♦** Supervision:

Our "Discovering Rocks" activities are suitable for children aged 5 to 12, with supervision by their own parent/guardian throughout the session.

Activities will involve handling a variety of rocks and other materials. Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring that children wash their hands thoroughly with soap after handling such materials and before eating.

Under 5s are welcome at no charge under the close supervision of their parent/guardian at all times.

Sessions will be led by Stibbington Centre's experienced, CRB-checked staff.

#### Programme:

Arrival should be at any time from 9.30 and departure at any time up to the end of the session at 12.30.

Families will be able to move between activities at their own pace.

A mid-morning drink and snack will be available at no additional charge.

By the end of the session children will have created several rock-related souvenirs to take home. In addition, a souvenir shop selling "pocket money" gifts will be available.
