Dear Parents/Carers,

As an exciting first-hand experience for the children in Year 1, we have booked a trip to visit Sacrewell Farm in Peterborough. The purpose of this trip is to allow the children to have an interactive experience with animals to support their learning in science and to go on a tractor ride and find out where plants in fields are grown. The children have been learning all about animals, plants and where their food comes from this year, so this will be a very valuable trip to bring together their learning this year.

We will be travelling via coach on **Monday 26th June 2017**. We will be leaving school at 9:30am and will be returning back to school for 3pm in time for normal pick up from the Year 1 classroom door.

We are asking for volunteers to help on this trip – please speak to a member of the year 1 team if you are available to help. There is no cost for adult helpers, however we will only need enough people to support the day, so we will let you know when we have enough volunteers. Please let us know (via email to the office or directly to the year 1 team) if you can help by **Monday 12th June 2017**.

Please could your child wear non-school uniform on this day with trainers you don't mind getting muddy, and they will require a waterproof coat. Children will either need to have a packed lunch with them this day with a drink or they will be able to get a High Five from the hall and will therefore only require a drink to bring with them for the coach.

To cover the cost of the trip, we are requesting a *voluntary* contribution of **£11.00** per child. *However, in cases of financial hardship and particularly for our families in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to subsidise your contribution. Circumstances such as these will be treated sympathetically; do come and talk to me if this is the case – Mrs Reynolds (Head Teacher).*

Although such a contribution is voluntary, should contributions received by the school render the trip to be considered not viable, it will be cancelled and all contributions refunded.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, please return the permission slip by email by **Monday 12th June 2017**. This will confirm your agreement to pay the voluntary contribution of £11.00 on ParentPay by **Friday 16th June 2017**.
