Dear Parent/Carer,

The Annual Country Dancing Festival is coming very soon and I would like to invite your child to take part.

This year the festival will be held on **Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2017** at **The Peterborough School**, Thorpe Road from **6:15-7:45pm**. **Please note we need a minimum of 16 children to partake otherwise we will not be able to attend the event.**

In order to prepare for the evening, we will be practising the dances during lunchtimes from 16<sup>th</sup> May- 8<sup>th</sup> June. Boys and girls from Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 are welcome to join.

Every year, the festival is a fun packed evening with many primary schools taking part. Children from across the city join in to perform the dances. The evening is supported by a live band and is often attended by local media.

Children are welcome to arrive from 5pm. It is a family event for parents/ carers and extended family members to enjoy together. Burgers, sausages, drinks, crisps, ice creams and sweets will be one sale before and during the event. Some families choose to bring along a small picnic to enjoy throughout the evening. There are a few seats available for each school but you may choose to bring along a blanket or fold away chair to secure yourself a seat.

Ample parking is available at The Peterborough School, which is on Thorpe Road, PE3 6AP. However, I have been informed that traffic queues are highly likely travelling in and out from the venue. Therefore, The Peterborough School are requesting that families car share where possible.

Girls will be provided with a skirt, waistcoat and neckerchief. Boys will be provided with a waistcoat and neckerchief and will need to wear grey school trousers or shorts. We ask that children wear comfortable shoes or trainers and a white polo shirt. Children will receive their outfit accompaniments on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> June.

On occasion, the evening has had to be cancelled due to poor weather. If The Peterborough School choose to cancel, we will endeavour to inform parents/carers as soon as possible, and certainly by the end of the school day on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June.

Please complete the slip below to indicate whether your child would like to attend the evening and return it to your child's class teacher by Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May. We ask that children attend with an adult (over 18 years of age- this could be a family member or under the supervision of a friend's parent), and meet at The Peterborough School at 6pm, when I will be there to greet them.
