Dear Parents/Carers

Year 4 will be having swimming lessons as part of their PE Lesson in the summer term; these lessons will be taking place on a Thursday morning 11.20am – 12.20pm pool time at Jack Hunt School.

The arrangements for swimming for next term are as follows:

19th April – 19th July 2018 (no session on 31st May) = 13 sessions.

The cost for the swimming lessons will be covered by the school, however it is necessary for us to ask for voluntary contributions from parents/carers towards the cost of transport and insurance. The bus and insurance is £3.00 per child per session and is payable as follows:

One payment of £39.00 for 13 sessions or part payment of £19.50 and another payment of £19.50 to be paid by Friday 1st June 2018.

In cases of financial hardship and particularly for our families in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to subsidise your contribution. Circumstances such as these will be treated sympathetically; do come and talk to me in confidence if this is the case. – Mrs Reynolds (Head Teacher)

Children should have a proper costume (no Bermuda shorts, wetsuits or Bikinis please) and a towel. If a child's hair covers their mouth or eyes, a swimming cap or other secure means of fixing hair should be used.

Please complete the consent form and return to school by Thursday 30th March 2018. Please can payments be paid on ParentPay and is required by Friday 1st June 2018.
