Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our work with PiXL (Partners in Excellence), your child has completed some summative assessments in *Maths, Reading, and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling*. The outcome of these tests are due to be shared with you at Consultation Evening.

You will receive an overview of your child's achievement within each area of learning which is coloured in red, amber or green.

Red	Either an area for development or an area that has not yet been taught this academic year
Amber	Your child is working towards this area of learning
Green	Your child is secure within this area of learning

We are just over the half way point in this academic year and the tests that your child has completed are based on the end of year expectations. Some of the content has not yet been taught and some learning will need further embedding prior to the child completing the end of the year tests at the end of the Summer Term.

Year 3 pupils have started a new Key Stage this year which also brings tighter constraints on test conditions. This brings a need for building speed and accuracy within accessing the test papers as well as accessing a Key Stage with higher expectations.

When you receive the overview for each test paper completed, please use these as a guide for your child's next steps. Your child's class teacher will be able to inform you which units have not yet been covered in class and therefore are red by default.
