Dear Parents/Carers

Year 4 are having swimming lessons as part of their PE Lesson this term, these lessons will be taking place on a Wednesday morning 11.15am – 12.00pm pool time at Jack Hunt School.

The arrangements for swimming for this term are as follows:

24th April – 10th July = 11 sessions.

The cost for the swimming lessons will be covered by the school, however it is necessary for us to ask for voluntary contributions from parents/carers towards the cost of transport and insurance. The bus and insurance is £3.00 per child per session and is payable as follows:

£33 for 11 sessions or one payment of £18.00 and another payment of £15.00.

In cases of financial hardship and particularly for our families in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to subsidise your contribution. Circumstances such as these will be treated sympathetically; do come and talk to me in confidence if this is the case. – Mrs Reynolds (Head Teacher)

Children should have a proper costume (no Bermuda shorts or Bikinis please) and a towel. If a child's hair covers their mouth or eyes, a swimming cap or other secure means of fixing hair should be used.

Please complete and sign consent form and return to school by Monday 22nd April 2013. Cheques should be made payable to 'Norwood Primary School'.

We would also be very grateful to any parent/carers who would be able to help out at the swimming pool, if any parent/carer is free to attend could you please let Miss Hoy know.
