

Attendance Policy

The attendance policy has been amended by the Local Authority and ratified by our Governing Body.

Please visit <u>School Polices</u> on our school website to familiarise yourself with the policy. Please pay attention to the <u>circumstances where a penalty notice may be</u> requested from the LA by the school and <u>absence</u> procedures.

Norwood Primary School aims to work together with our parents/carers to ensure that all children registered at the school attend both regularly and punctually. We value every child as an individual and believe that every child has an entitlement to education, enabling them to achieve their full potential.

At Norwood we monitor attendance and late arrivals of our pupils and work very closely with our Local Authority Attendance Officer. We will make contact with parents/carers by letter if we are concerned about either lateness or poor attendance. If poor attendance/lateness continues this could instigate involvement of the Local Authority Attendance Officer in requesting a meeting to discuss the concerns.

Norwood Primary School has a Governor Attendance Panel and any absences that are not deemed as exceptional circumstance will be unauthorised.

Absence Reporting

If your child is unwell and unable to attend school please contact school on 01733 574717 by **8.45am** to let us know on the first day of absence. There is an answer machine on which you can leave a message if no-one in the office is available to take your call.

Should the school office not receive a reason for absence on the first day, they will endeavour to contact parents/carers to check the safety of the child. As part of our Safeguarding procedures, if the school is unable to make contact with parent/carer or other emergency contact, a safe and well check will be carried out by school and/or police. Please remember that if your child has sickness or diarrhoea they must be kept off school for a minimum of 48 hours from the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting. This is to reduce the risk of infection to other children and adults in school.

Christmas Jumper Day 2017

We will again be taking part in Christmas Jumper Day 2017 in aid of Save the Children.

This will take place on **Friday 15th December 2017**. Children and staff are invited to come to school in school uniform but wearing a Christmas Jumper over school shirts/blouses. In return we ask for a minimum donation of £1.
