

## **Grapes**

Please can we ask parents/carers to make sure that grapes are cut in half lengthwise and not sent in whole. We are seeing more and more lunchboxes containing whole grapes which cause a choke hazard for children.

#### **Absence Reporting**

If your child is unwell and unable to attend school please can we remind **parents/carers to contact school** on 01733 574717 by **8.45am** to let us know on the first day of absence. We are currently having to remind parents/carers frequently about ensuring school is notified on a daily basis about an absence and before 8.45am. There is an answer machine on which you can leave a message if no-one in the office is available to take your call.

Should the school office not receive a reason for absence on the first day, they will endeavour to contact parents/carers to check the safety of the child. As part of our Safeguarding procedures, if the school is unable to make contact with parent/carer or other emergency contact, a safe and well check will be carried out by school and/or police.

## **Medical Appointments**

Can we also remind parents/carers that if your child has a medical appointment during school hours, the school office will need to be provided with the **appointment card/letter/text/email in order to authorise the absence**. The correspondence also needs to be shown when a child is collected early from school.

#### **Cold Weather**

While the weather continues to be very cold, please can you ensure that all pupils come to school with a coat and suitable winter wear (scarves, hats and gloves). Please can we remind parents/carers to name all items.

#### **Consultation Evenings**
