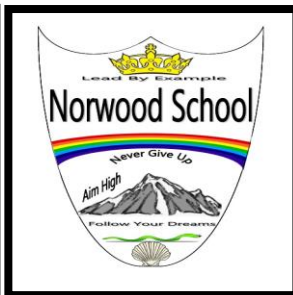

Medical/Illness

Just to remind parents/carers that the only medication allowed in school for pupils are asthma inhalers, allergic reaction medicine, prescribed medicines requiring **four or more doses daily**.

Only parents/carers are to bring medication to the school office and consent forms will need to be signed. All medicine brought to the school office must be in the bottle in which they were dispensed clearly labelled with the child's name, the dosage and frequency of dosage.
