


# Norwood Primary School NEWSLETTER End of School Year 2017/2018 Head Teacher—Mrs D Reynolds

## Year 2 Pupils

Just to remind our current Year 2 parents/carers that from the Autumn Term children will no longer qualify to receive a '*Universal Free School Meal'* as part of the government's initiative for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils. If your child is eligible to receive Free School Meals (if you are in receipt of a qualifying benefit), then your child's meals will continue to be free. Also high five is no longer an option in KS2 (Years 3-6).

If you think you could be eligible for Free School Meals, please contact Miss Fletcher for an application form to complete. Also, children will no longer be provided with free fruit at break time. Children can bring a healthy snack from home, such as fruit or cut vegetables. **Please remember that Norwood is a nut free school**.

### **Medication**

Could we please remind you that it is parent/carers responsibility to collect all medication/inhalers from the school office, that is in school for your child/children, at the end of an academic year and take them home for the summer. Please enure you bring all in date medication/inhalers back in September and complete the relevant paperwork.
