Rainbows learn by doing - they get their hands dirty with arts and crafts, cooking and playing games. Rainbows are girls aged five to seven (four to seven in Northern Ireland) who follow a programme called the Rainbow Jigsaw, through which they can take part in lots of different activities with girls their own age.
