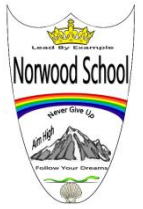

Outcomes to date:

Progress across school in all assessed curriculum areas has been good or better.

Learning skills and confidence have developed as an additional positive outcome of any intervention.

Year 6 children have achieved well with a 37% of the whole cohort making accelerated progress in Maths from their KS1 outcomes. 19 % of the PP cohort made accelerated progress.

Year 6 children have achieved well with a 27% of the whole cohort making accelerated progress in English from their KS1 outcomes. 38 % of the PP cohort made accelerated progress.
