

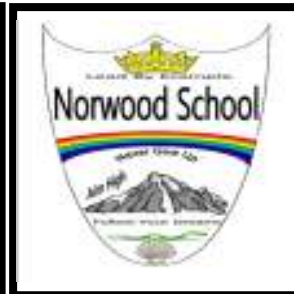

The fine is now **£60 per child per parent/carer**, which if unpaid after 28 days rises to **£120 per child per parent/carer**.
