Nut Free School

Please may we **again** remind parents/carers that Norwood Primary School is a **nut free school**. This means that it is not permissible for children or adults to bring to school any foods that may contain nuts, including peanut butter, chocolate and hazelnut spread, cakes and cereal bars. We have several pupils within school that have severe nut allergies and require epi-pens. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.
