Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you that on Thursday 4th October 2018 we are taking our 1st trip of the year. We are going to 'Survive or Thrive' as part of our Bronze Age learning at Flag Fen. It is a hands on experimental approach to exploring our rich prehistoric past. The day's activities develop practical skills and confidence as well as knowledge and understanding of how our prehistoric ancestors lived. Will you survive or thrive in a day in the life of our forebears? Our day will involve activities such as prehistoric building, medicine, art, cookery and looking at how nettles were used as well as storytelling in a Bronze Age roundhouse.

We will aim to leave school at 9:30am so arrival on the morning of the day should be as per normal.

Please make sure children bring a coat, packed lunch and plenty of water to drink throughout the day. Children who are entitled to Free School Meals will have a packed lunch provided from the school kitchen. Please make sure your child brings a suitable rucksack to store this in. Children will NOT be required to wear school uniform that day as some of the activities can be quite messy, children should wear outdoor footwear e.g. trainers or wellies, and outdoor clothing as appropriate to the weather. If you have any questions about this please speak to Miss Johnson. We will be back at school by 2:30pm so please collect your child as normal.

As a school we are offered a favourable price to visit, so to cover the cost of this and the cost of transport, we are asking for a contribution of £11.00 per child to enable us to ensure this trip can go ahead, to be paid through the school's Parentpay system.

In cases of financial hardship and particularly for our families in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to subsidise your contribution. Circumstances such as these will be treated sympathetically; do come and talk to me in confidence if this is the case. – Mrs Reynolds (Head Teacher)

Although such a contribution is voluntary, should contributions received by the school render the trip to be considered not viable, it will be cancelled and all contributions will be refunded.

Please can the permission slip and payment be returned by Monday 1st October 2018.

As always, we will try and cover adult to child ratio with school adults BUT should this not be the case a message to ask for helpers will be sent out.
