Our Harvest Festival assembly will be taking place on **Monday 21st October 2013**. Like last year, we will be supporting Peterborough Foodbank. Juliet Welch from Peterborough Foodbank will be coming in and talking to the children about the work of the charity.

This worthy charity is designed to help individuals and families in crisis, through the provision of emergency food supplies. Local professional care-workers in the Peterborough area refer them to the foodbank centre where they are given their food supplies, a cup of coffee and help in finding other professionals who can help them out of their crisis. The foodbank also supports existing agencies working with the distressed and destitute by donating food in bulk.
