

Our Good Conduct Code

- All visitors to Kingswood will respect and observe the Centre rules & regulations.
- All guests will treat the Centre with respect at all times. Particular care should be taken of the woodland, grass and planted areas.
- To use the litterbins provided at all times
- All guests will treat one another with respect, regardless of race, religion, gender or special educational needs.
- The unsupervised use of activity areas and equipment is strictly forbidden.
- During any activity session the Kingswood instructor in charge is responsible for the safety of all participants. All participants will therefore follow his/her direction at all times and will not do anything that may compromise their own or any other person's safety.

NB: If an activity requires students to go off-site, an adult member of the school may be asked to accompany the group if deemed necessary by the Kingswood instructor.

- Accommodation will be kept clean and tidy at all times. Any damage to Kingswood property should be reported and any arising payment required to make good will be settled prior to departure from the Centre.
- All guests will be prompt for sessions and meal times to avoid delays or severely curtailed activities.
- All students will return to their accommodation at the time agreed with Kingswood. Noise should be kept to a minimum at all times and, except in cases of emergency, visitors will remain in their accommodation until the time agreed. Groups will not disturb any other groups by being noisy late at night and in the early hours of the morning
- All guests under 18 years old do not consume alcohol.

To recognise, improve and reward positive student behaviour, we have introduced the Kingswood 'Cool To Be Kind' wrist bands. Many schools present them each morning to selected pupils on merit. Bands are available at a nominal charge from the reception at your centre or can be purchased when making your booking.
