Dear Parents/Carers,

Due to its popularity, we are once again going to be holding our very own Race for Life on **27th June 2019**.

Throughout the course of the day, all pupils will take part in the event in order to raise money for Cancer Research UK. Pupils will each be given a blank sponsorship form to bring home and collect sponsors.

Every contribution, no matter how big or small is one step closer to beating Cancer and as a school we would like to do our bit to support such a wonderful cause. If the individual sponsoring the pupil is a UK tax payer, please encourage them to tick the gift aid box on the form. This will increase their donation by 25% at no extra cost to the individual. Sponsor money will then be due in by no later than **Thursday 11th July 2019**, therefore giving us time to calculate the total amount raised before the end of the school year. All money will then be sent on together.

KS1 and KS2 will complete the run separately with KS1 going out onto the field during the morning at 9:15am and KS2 following suit in the afternoon, starting at 1:30pm. Like last year, there will be no set amount for the pupils to complete as the emphasis is on taking part, trying their best and raising money for such a wonderful cause. Pupils may choose to run, skip, walk or even dance their way around the course. Therefore, no-one will be pressurised to do more than they so wish.

Pupils should come to school in their Sports kit- including something pink! This could be as small as pink laces or it could be a pink t-shirt. If you were feeling really brave why not wear a pink tutu or a pink wig! Pupils must bring a water bottle with them, which can be accessed during the event. Sun cream must also be applied in the morning if appropriate.

Each pupil will also be given a name card to wear on their backs which they can use to write their own message. This could be for a loved one who has suffered from a form of Cancer or it could be a generic message for all of those who have or are suffering from Cancer. All pupils who take part in the event will receive a medal for participation.
