


Norwood Primary School NEWSLETTER July 2019

Year 2 Pupils

Just to remind our current Year 2 parents/carers that from the Autumn Term children will no longer qualify to receive a 'Universal Free School Meal' as part of the government's initiative for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils. If your child is eligible to receive Free School Meals (if you are in receipt of a qualifying benefit), then your child's meals will continue to be free. If you think you could be eligible for free school meals, please contact Miss Fletcher for an application form to complete.



Also, children will no longer be eligible for the government programme which provided a piece of free fruit or vegetable at break time which is only available for KS1. Children can bring a healthy snack from home, such as fruit or cut vegetables.

Please remember that Norwood is a nut free school.
