Permission form for the Provision of Care – Children in KS1 and Foundation Stage

Children at primary school are usually able to use the toilet in an independent and appropriate way; however there may be times when further support is required. This requirement maybe due to a special need or through a tummy bug for example. To implement our Intimate Care Policy it is important that we have permission from parents/carers prior to adult intervention in these cases.

On the rare occasion where a child soils themselves while they are at school it is important that measures are taken to have them changed (and if necessary cleaned) as quickly as possible. Our staff members are experienced at carrying out this task if you wish them to do so or, if preferred, the school can contact you or your emergency contact who will be asked to attend without delay.
