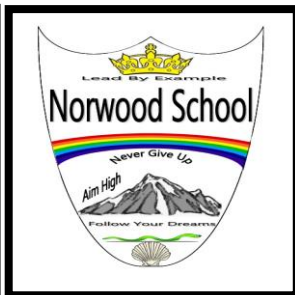

Welcome Back

Spare Uniform for Reception Class

Adult Collection of Children
