Dear Parent/Carer

Today, your child will bring home their most recent set of assessments that they have completed in school.

- Reading
- Arithmetic and Problem Solving and Reasoning
- Spelling and Grammar

These assessments are based on ***end of year expectations*** and will provide you with an understanding of the content of learning, skills and knowledge your children needs to acquire to be at age related expectation by the end of the year.

The answers provided in pencil were those completed in test conditions, timed and independent (adults are allowed to help with the reading of the questions in maths and grammar only).

The purple annotated answers are those that the children have completed when reviewing their work in a supported learning environment.

For children to be at end of year expectations (June 2020) they would need to achieve a score as follows in each of the subject areas:-

**Reading 17/30**

**Maths 39/75**

**Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling 26/50**

Children can also attain Greater Depth in each subject with the following marks being required for this to be awarded:-

**Reading 25/30**

**Maths 65/75**

**Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling 40/50**
