As you are no doubt aware, the end of Key Stage 2 SATs (tests) will be taking place next term. The SATs will begin on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> of May and end on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> May with one or two tests each morning comprising of GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling), Reading, and Mathematics. We will endeavour to make these as relaxed as humanly possible and have a reduced academic timetable for the times during the week when we are not assessing. With this in mind, weather permitting, we will have PE and creative activities each afternoon for the duration of the week. Rest assured that your children are ready and have made incredible progress in their learning this year – they and you should be rightly proud of them.
