Dear Parent/Carer

A reminder to parents/carers that if children or members of staff who have a new and persistent cough **or** a temperature of 37.8 or over, must self-isolate for a full 14 days. Should children start to exhibit these symptoms whilst in school, parents/carers will be contacted with a requirement to collect their child to self-isolate for 14 days.

School is working hard to ensure that your children have access to learning should there be a need for them to 'self-isolate' or there are any part or whole school closures.

In addition to this:

- Year 2 and Year 6 had learning sent home on Friday 13th March – if you have not received this, please let your class adult know.
- Reception and Year 1 children will receive a paper copy of a learning pack of Maths and Literacy games.
- Year 1 – 6 will have activities set on Seesaw that they can respond to, answer questions, upload learning and share with their teachers. The children will need to use their usual login to Seesaw or the QR code which is stuck in an exercise book – **children's log on to be used NOT adults** – to access and share back their learning.
- Year 1 – 6 will also have exercise books sent home if they would like to record their learning as a paper copy. Seesaw then allows for learning to be photographed and uploaded back to Seesaw.

Please can children in Year 3 - 6 continue to use Bedrock, which can be accessed daily.

Children from Year 1 – 6 have access to the PiXL Table app and PiXL Unlock which can be accessed daily.

PiXL Unlock app supports the development of vocabulary and is an app that needs downloading from an app store.

Your child's PiXL login covers both these apps. The 'School ID' is NP5120.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 continue to have access to Teach Your Monster to Read.

Children in Year 2 to 6 have access to RWI Spelling 'Extra Practice Zone' via a whole class login.

All login have previously been provided for the sites that required this, however if your child is unsure, they should speak to their child's class teacher. Alternatively, you can contact the school office, via email or phone, and staff will support with this wherever possible.
