

Dear Parents/Carers

Norwood School has a well-stocked library facility that children have regular access to. Each child has an allowance of two books that may be changed on a regular basis.

From September we are raising the profile of our library and therefore need to ensure that the library is treated with respect by both children and supporting parent/carers. With this in mind, we will run the school library in line with the principles of a public library. The system allows a maximum of two books per child and requires books to be checked back in before allowing further books to be checked out.

To support with these principles, and to ensure a quality provision is available for all, we have enhanced our library support.

- For year group Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, Mrs Woods is available for a session each morning to support with returning books and selecting a new appropriate reading choice.
- Key stage 2 children, Year 3, 4, 5 and 6, have at least weekly access during class time to change their books.
- In addition to this provision, the Lunch Club is open for a period of time during the dinner time, and our children can take this opportunity to change their reading materials.

To support school's commitment to ensuring a quality provision for all of our children we required the on-going support of parents and carers across school. Please can you complete the following agreement to ensure we can work together to ensure the very best for our children.
