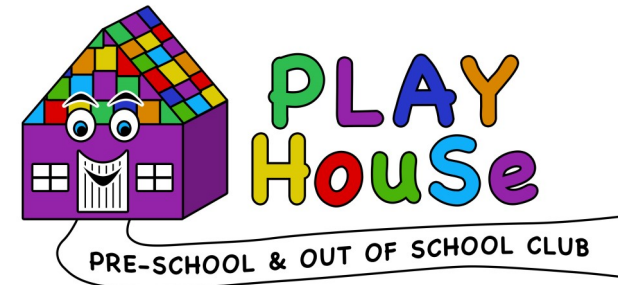

# WELCOME

This leaflet is intended to be as informative as possible to help you decide whether Play House Pre-School and Out of School Club is the most suitable provision for your child.

- ◆ The setting is open to every family in the community, and wider.
- ◆ We are open for approximately 52 weeks of the year.
- ◆ We are open Monday to Friday, excluding Bank Holidays.
- ◆ The Breakfast Club is open from 7.00am through to 8.45am.
- ◆ The After School Club is open from 3.15pm to 6.00pm.
- ◆ We have walking buses to and from Norwood Primary School and Gunthorpe Primary School.
- ◆ The Holiday Club is open during school holiday periods from 7am to 6pm.
- ◆ We provide breakfast, if needed by the child, a snack after school and a very light tea/snack if the child stays at the after school club after 4.30pm.
- ◆ We do take childcare vouchers.
- ◆ We are non profit making and a registered charity.



## WHAT FACILITIES ARE THERE?

- ◆ The children have free flow access to the play areas/rooms.
- ◆ The children have direct access to the outdoor play area where we have a fully enclosed garden area equipped with playhouse, willow den, astro-turf, plus a selection of play equipment. We also have areas where children can dig and grow flowers and vegetables. The garden is regularly maintained and provides a pleasant area for the children to enjoy.
- ◆ Healthy snacks are provided each session and are prepared in the on-site kitchen.
- ◆ There are child-sized toilet facilities for boys and girls.
- ◆ Adult and disabled/baby changing toilet facilities are also available.
- ◆ Off-street car parking area.

## WHAT WILL MY CHILD BE DOING?



- ◆ All our activities are planned and incorporate child initiated learning.
- ◆ Children will be given the opportunities to:
  - ◆ Play alone;
  - ◆ Play with other children;
  - ◆ Make new friends;
  - ◆ Take turns;
  - ◆ Care for one another;
  - ◆ Speak and listen.
- ◆ Paint, glue, crayon, chalk and use scissors.
- ◆ Model with construction, play dough, clay, etc.
- ◆ Dress up and pretend.
- ◆ Dance, sing songs and play musical instruments.
- ◆ Listen to stories and enjoy books.
- ◆ Explore outside and find out about the world.
