Pupils will not be charged for material used for their work in school.

It is necessary to ask parents/carers to make a voluntary contribution for school trips both day and residential. The school will not exclude children if they are unable to make the voluntary contribution. If insufficient voluntary contributions are received then the trip will have to be cancelled.

Residential trips

If the school organises a residential visit in school time or mainly school time, which is to provide education directly related to the National Curriculum, we do not make any charge for the education. However, we do make a charge to cover the costs of board, lodging and travel expenses.

Music tuition

All children study music as part of the normal school curriculum. We do not charge for this. There is a charge for individual or group music tuition if this is not part of the National Curriculum. The peripatetic music teachers teach individual or small group lessons. We make a charge for these lessons. We give parents/carers information about additional music tuition at the start of each academic year.

Extra Curricula Clubs

At times certain extra curricular clubs provided and / or hosted by Norwood School may incur a charge.

For all above activities please see the Head Teacher if you are unable to make a voluntary contribution as there is a small amount of money available to help in such cases.

Charges will be made if a child loses or wilfully damages school equipment.
