**Pre-reads are available for children in Red, Green, Purple, Orange, Yellow, Blue and Grey group. Pupils in group *Grey A*, will not have a 'pre-read'.**

Each Friday, your child will be allocated with their next book to read online ready for the following week. This is known as the 'pre-read'. We would appreciate your time to help your child to read this book for the following Monday. This will replace the paper book version that was previously sent home in bookbags.

Children who read the pre-read at home are at an advantage and progress through the Read Write Inc groups quicker as they already have some understanding of the content.

Log in details will be sent home in your child's bookbag and the first book will be allocated on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June.

Please note: if your child is in the Grey A group, there are no pre-read books currently available either as paper copies or online. As soon as they become available, we will let you know.

If you are unable to access the books online or have difficulty logging in, please speak to your child's class teacher.

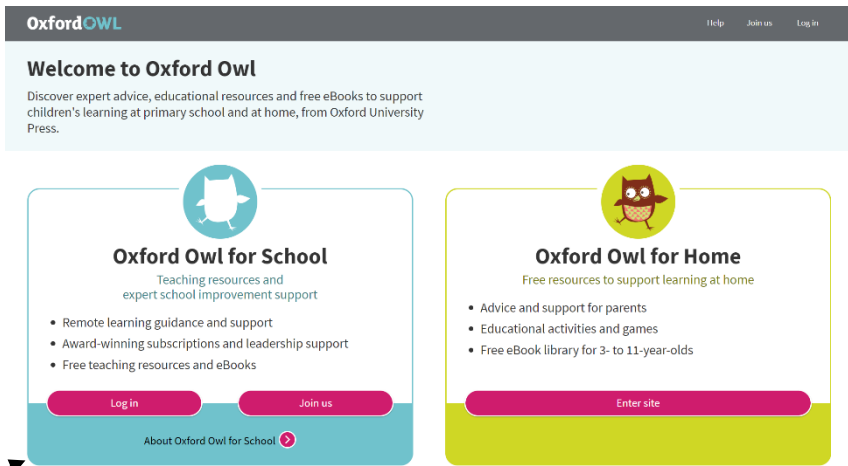

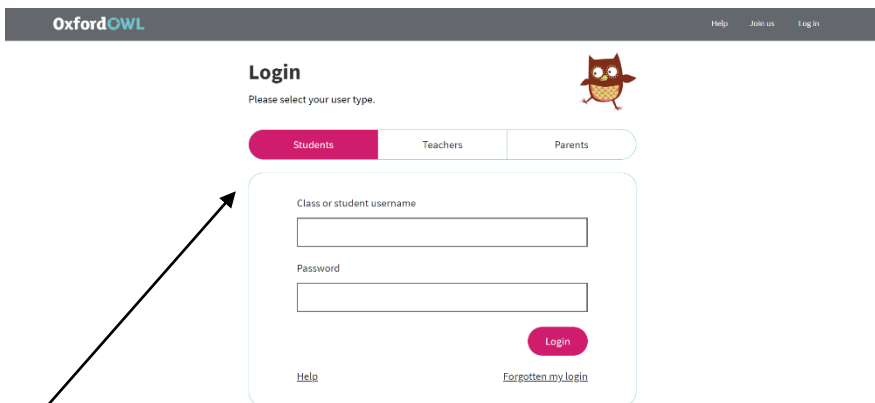

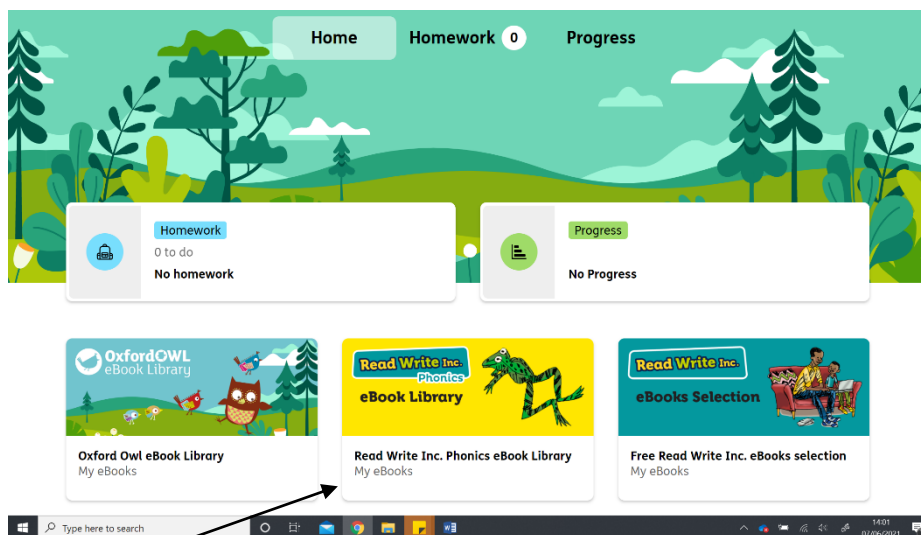




1. Click 'Log in' within the Oxford Owl for School section



2. Make sure the 'Student' tab is highlighted and input your child's username and password. You will then be prompted to type in the school code.
