Dear Parents/Carers

On **Thursday 26th June 2014**, we are hoping to take Year 2 & 3 pupils with Year 4 to Cadbury's World in Birmingham. Year 2 are learning about Charlie and The Chocolate Factory, a topic which year 3 did last year, and Year 4 have been studying where chocolate comes from and how it is made. We expect to learn even more about the story of chocolate when we visit Cadbury's World and perhaps even have a go at making our own chocolate while we are there!

Children should wear their school uniforms to ensure easy identification while we are there. They will need coats in the event of rain and sensible school shoes.

We will be departing school at 9.15am and ask that children **are at school** by 8.45am, to allow us to make sure all children are present and organise them into their appropriate groups. We will return back to school for **5.00pm** so could you please ensure that you have made the appropriate arrangements on this day to ensure your child is collected on time.

Since it is an all day trip, children will need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, the school kitchen will prepare a packed lunch for him/her. If you would prefer to provide your child's packed lunch from home, please indicate on the slip attached. Your child will also need to bring a water bottle and a snack.

As previously corresponded in a letter to parents and carers on Tuesday 23rd July 2013, Norwood School Association will be generously contributing £10 per child per year towards the cost of a school trip. We have decided that it would be a wonderful use of this donation to help pay for the costs of Year 2 & 3's trip to Cadbury's World. As a result of this, the trip that would usually cost £20 per child has been reduced dramatically to a *voluntary* contribution of £10 per child.

Although such a contribution is voluntary, should contributions received by the school render the trip to be considered not viable, it will be cancelled and all contributions will be refunded. In cases of financial hardship and particularly for our families in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to subsidise your contribution. Circumstances such as these will be treated sympathetically; do come and talk to me in confidence if this is the case. – Mrs Reynolds (Head Teacher)
