Dear Parents/Carers,

In our topic work post-Sats, Year 6 will be exploring the topic of theme parks. All of our lessons will be linked to this theme including: designing their own theme park, using computing and maths to calculate running costs, creating advertisements and recording radio advertisements in English, designing, building and painting their own ride booth in Design and Technology and Logo in Art and Design. This will all eventually lead to Year 6 organising and running Norwood School Summer Fair.

It is a fabulous topic with rich and exciting learning opportunities and as part of their learning we would like to take the children to Twin Lakes Theme Park near Melton Mowbray. The visit has been booked for **Friday 24th June 2022**, leaving school at 9.15am and returning to school at 4.00pm. The total cost of the trip is £31.50.

We would normally be able to bring this trip in under £30, however due to rising fuel costs, both the coach company and Theme Park have raised their prices. Whilst five adults will be supporting the children on this trip, the adult's entry to the park is free and no charges other than the coach and entry for each child is included in the cost.

To cover the cost of this trip, including transport, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £31.50 per pupil.

Payment arrangements have been set up on ParentPay.

- Deposit of £16.50 to be paid by **Monday 9th May 2022**
- Balance of £15.00 to be paid by **Monday 6th June 2022**

However, in cases of financial hardship and particularly for our families in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to subsidise your contribution. Circumstances such as these will be treated sympathetically; do come and talk to me if this is the case – Mrs Reynolds (Head Teacher).

Although such a contribution is voluntary, should contributions received by the school render the trip to be considered not viable, the trip will be cancelled and contributions will be refunded.

Pupils will need a packed lunch and their water bottle. It is recommended that pupils bring their lunches in a disposable bag, meaning packaging can be thrown away once lunch has been eaten. Children who are entitled to Free School Meals will have a packed lunch provided from the school kitchen. Pupils can wear non-school uniform with suitable walking shoes and will need to bring a waterproof coat. Please note that no cameras or phones are to be taken on this trip.
