

Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to invite you to our Norwood School Sports Morning which is due to take place on **Wednesday 29th June 2022,** weather permitting, on the school field. This event will involve all children from Reception to Year 6. The event will begin at approximately 9am and we will aim to finish by 11.30am. After dropping children to their classroom doors please can parents/carers gather on the school field.

Please note that if due to weather and/or ground conditions we are unable to proceed with the sports morning, parents/carers will be informed via email/Xpressions as soon as the decision is made.

To help with a prompt start at 9.00am, please can **all** children arrive at school in their sports kits wearing a coloured t-shirt the same as their 'House' colour (if you are unsure of these, please ask the class teacher). Children will need to change back into uniform after the event so please bring school uniform and school shoes in a named carrier bag. Please ensure your child/children have a water bottle and a sun hat in school on this day and an all-day sun cream has been applied before coming into school.

The format for the event will run in a similar way to previous years where children have an opportunity to work as a team in the 'Field events' to win as many points for their House as possible. All children will compete in a carousel of activities. The children will work in their own house carousel and work in a team consisting of their 'Family members' – ranging from Year Reception to Year 6. Children will earn points in these events: ball back, football dribble, target shot (throwing) and shot put.

For the 'track events', each child in Reception or Key Stage 1 will take part in either the bean bag or sprint. Children in Key Stage 2 will take part in the sprint or long distance race. We have used PE lessons to carry out heats for each Key Stage to determine which children qualify for the relay races. The relay race will be run by the *fastest children in the house for each Key Stage*.

The Governing Body Sports Day Shield will be engraved to record the overall winning house for this year.

We hope that you can join us for Sports Morning and celebrate in the sporting success of all of our children and cheer on the children who have made it through to the final.
