Dear Parents/Carers

As this year is the Centenary of the start of World War 1, we are delighted to share with you the exciting opportunity for our year 4 and 5 pupils. Year 4 and 5 pupils have been given the chance to join with other children across the city and the Peterborough Youth Choir in a celebration project and performance.

Over the next few weeks, the children will be learning six songs that are related to World War 1 which they will then perform, along with over 800 other children, in a special concert held at Kingsgate Conference Centre in June. There will also be opportunities for the children to be involved in Workshops and other singing events in the build up to the performance. Project: World War One Centenary Concerts

Brief introduction: The first of four events as part of our Arts Council England funded project in partnership with Peterborough Music Hub to develop the provision for singing in the city's schools. With over 850 pupils participating on each day, and special performances from both Peterborough Youth Choir and the Miraculum Children's Choir from the Kodály School, Kecskemét, Hungary - all accompanied by a wartime-styled professional orchestra – this promises to be a remarkable evening of entertainment.

Ticket prices: Tickets £6. Premium seats £10. Accompanied children free.
