

Welcome to the first SEN newsletter of the year.

I can't believe it's October already! I do hope that your children are feeling settled at school and are getting back into routine. It can be so difficult after the Summer Holidays.

Across school, the number of children with Special Educational Needs is increasing with many children joining us with a diagnosis of Autism or gaining a diagnosis of Autism during their time with us. It can be very difficult for children with Autism to make sense of the world of school and we aim to keep it as consistent as possible to reduce anxiety.

The pathway for assessing a child for Autism in Peterborough is through the Social and Emotional Pathway. This involves an Early Help Assessment and the expectation that parents/carers complete a Parenting Programme for 12 weeks. After 6 weeks of embedding the strategies, I am then allowed to refer to the Community Paediatrician for a child to be considered for an assessment. 


