Dear Parents/Carers,

Our topic within Geography this term is Coastal Processes and in Science we are looking at Living Things and Their habitats. As part of our learning, and for pupils to get a real life experience of the above, I would like to take them to the Sea Life Centre in Hunstanton, and then weather permitting onto the beach. We will be going on **Monday 6th February 2023**.

To cover the cost of this trip, including transport, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£22.00** per pupil. Full payment will need to be paid on ParentPay and permission received via admin@norwoodschool.co.uk no later than Wednesday 1st February 2023. **Although such a contribution is voluntary, should contributions received by the school render the trip to be considered not viable, it will be cancelled and all contributions will be refunded.**

However, in cases of financial hardship and particularly for our families in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to subsidise your contribution. Circumstances such as these will be treated sympathetically; do come and talk to me if this is the case – Mrs Reynolds (Head Teacher).

We will be leaving school at 9:00am and will be looking to return at approximately 4:45 -5pm, traffic permitting. Please note this is out of school hours and therefore pupils will need to be collected from school.

Due to the nature of the trip we are allowing the pupils to bring spending money if they wish (maximum £5.00) as we will visit the shop. Please ensure that the pupils have their money in a secure named envelope or purse/ wallet. The group's adult will keep hold of it until they reach the shop.

Pupils are not expected to wear school uniform for this trip but must wear sensible clothing. We would suggest they wear something old, as if we do make it on the beach, we could get a bit sandy! Pupils must also come in sensible footwear – trainers would be best. Please can all pupils also bring a coat with them as it is likely to be windy.

Pupils will need a packed lunch and a drink of water. It is recommended that pupils bring their lunches in a plastic bag, meaning it can be thrown away once eaten. We would also recommend that pupils bring additional snacks with them due to the duration of the event. Those pupils who are in receipt of free school meals, will be given a packed lunch prepared by the school kitchen.

The journey will take about 1 hour and 15 minutes, if any child requires medication for travel sickness this needs to be given in the morning before coming to school. Please note, we are not able to give medication to any pupils. If your child therefore requires medication on the way home, they will need to take medication that will last the day or alternatively we would recommend a travel sickness bracelet.
