Welcome

This leaflet is intended to be as informative as possible to help you decide whether Play House Pre-School and Out of School Club is the most suitable provision for your child.

- The setting is open to every family in the community, and wider.
- We are open for approximately 50 weeks of the year.
- We are open Monday to Friday, excluding Bank Holidays.
- The Breakfast Club is open from 7.15am through to 8.45am.
- The After School Club is open from 3.15pm to 6.00pm.
- We have walking buses to and from Norwood Primary School and Gunthorpe Primary School.
- The Holiday Club is open during school holiday periods from 7.30am to 5.30pm.
- We provide breakfast, if needed by the child, a snack after school and a very light tea/snack if the child stays at the after school club after 4.45pm.
- ♦ We do take childcare vouchers.
- We are non profit making and a registered charity.



What Facilities are there?

- The children have free flow access to the play areas/rooms.
- The children have direct access to the outdoor play area where we have a fully enclosed garden area equipped with playhouse, climbing frame, astroturf, plus a selection of play equipment. We also have areas where children can dig and grow flowers and vegetables. The garden is regularly maintained and provides a pleasant area for the children to enjoy.
- Healthy snacks are provided each session and are prepared in the onsite kitchen.
- Included in the fees are all food, drinks, snacks and activities.
- There are child-sized toilet facilities for boys and girls.
- Adult and disabled/baby changing toilet facilities are also available.
- Off-street car parking area.



What will my child be doing?
