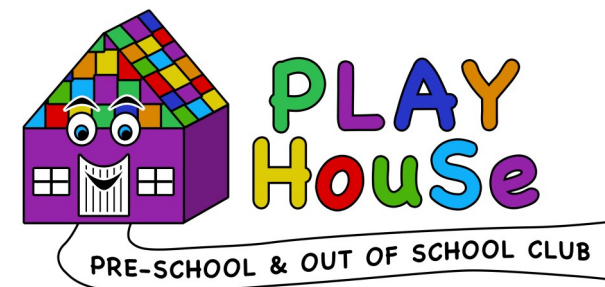

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Information Leaflet



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Welcome

This leaflet is intended to be as informative as possible to help you decide whether Play House Pre-School and Out of School Club is the most suitable provision for your child.

- ♦ The setting is open to every family in the community, and wider.
- ♦ We are open for approximately 50 weeks of the year.
- ♦ We are open Monday to Friday, excluding Bank Holidays.
- ♦ The Breakfast Club is open from 7.15am through to 8.45am.
- ♦ The After School Club is open from 3.15pm to 6.00pm.
- ♦ We have walking buses to and from Norwood Primary School and Gunthorpe Primary School.
- ♦ The Holiday Club is open during school holiday periods from 7.30am to 5.30pm.
- ♦ We provide breakfast, if needed by the child, a snack after school and a very light tea/snack if the child stays at the after school club after 4.45pm.
- ♦ We do take childcare vouchers.
- ♦ We are non profit making and a registered charity.



What Facilities are there?

- ♦ The children have free flow access to the play areas/rooms.
- ♦ The children have direct access to the outdoor play area where we have a fully enclosed garden area equipped with playhouse, climbing frame, astro-turf, plus a selection of play equipment. We also have areas where children can dig and grow flowers and vegetables. The garden is regularly maintained and provides a pleasant area for the children to enjoy.
- ♦ Healthy snacks are provided each session and are prepared in the on-site kitchen.
- ♦ Included in the fees are all food, drinks, snacks and activities.
- ♦ There are child-sized toilet facilities for boys and girls.
- ♦ Adult and disabled/baby changing toilet facilities are also available.
- ♦ Off-street car parking area.



What will my child be doing?

- ♦ All our activities are planned and incorporate child initiated learning.
- ♦ Children will be given the opportunities to:
 - ♦ Play alone;
 - ♦ Play with other children;
 - ♦ Make new friends;
 - ♦ Take turns;
 - ♦ Care for one another;
 - ♦ Speak and listen.
- ♦ Paint, glue, crayon, chalk and use scissors.
- ♦ Model with construction, play dough, clay, etc.
- ♦ Dress up and pretend.
- ♦ Dance, sing songs and play musical instruments.
- ♦ Listen to stories and enjoy books.
- ♦ Explore outside and find out about the world.
