



Year 6 ONLY pupils in September 2023



September - School Meal price increase

From Monday 4th September 2023 the cost of a school meal for KS2 pupils will increase to **£3.30 a day**.

- Reception and KS1 pupils will continue to be eligible for a universal free school meal and there will be no change.
- Pupils who receive a free school meal there will be no change.
