




Norwood School welcomes you to our Sports Day. We want to take this opportunity to thank you for attending and hope you enjoy the event!

Taking on board the feedback given after last year's event, a range of changes have been made:

- In order to provide pupils with the opportunity to participate in more events, the morning has now been split into two sessions.
- The 'pod' activities have now taken place during National Sports Week and these totals will be added to the totals achieved on Sports Day.
- Where possible, sibling races have been staggered to enable those spectating to watch both children. In the majority of cases, parents / carers will be standing between the two tracks which their children will be on.
- Reception and KS1 will compete in more traditional events whereas KS2 will have a more Olympic style approach.
- All pupils who race will receive stickers for participation. Those achieving 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be given corresponding stickers
- Medals will be awarded to all those involved in the Best of the Best Relay this year including 4th place.
- Special awards for Sportsmanship, Excellent Effort and the Supportive Stars are also up for grabs!
- The House Cup and Special awards will be awarded in assembly on Friday 14th July 2023.

When you enter the field, please head to the designated area for each year group. This will be labelled and also can be seen on the diagram below. If you are supporting pupils in different year groups, if possible please stand in between. Please can I remind parents / carers that they are not to stand on the track or go over the pupils at any point during the event for Safeguarding reasons.
