As it is the start of another academic year, I wanted to remind everyone about the expectations for PE kit.

PE Kit

Outdoor kit - plain white t-shirt, plain black or grey jumper (no hood or full zip), plain black shorts, plain black or grey tracksuit bottoms, white socks and trainers or plimsolls.

Indoor kit – plain white t-shirt, plain black shorts and trainers or plimsolls.

Black, non-see-through leggings are also acceptable.

Red jumpers are not allowed to be worn. Staff will make a decision as to whether or not the PE kit is suitable. Clothing that has a logo or brand on show is not deemed appropriate. A small logo is ok. Please note, outdoor PE will go ahead in all weathers unless it is deemed unsafe.

PE Kit donations

If anyone has any old or spare PE kit at home that is no longer needed, we would be grateful if these could be donated to school in order to add to our spare kit box. This will help to ensure that all pupils are taking part in PE, in the correct kit, for all lessons.

Health and Safety

As mentioned above, there must be no hoods or full length zips on the jumper as these pose a health and safety risk to the pupil wearing them.

All long hair must be tied up and out of the pupils' eyes.

All jewellery must be removed.

Earrings are not allowed to be worn so must be taken out prior to the lesson. If the child is unable to do this for themselves, plasters or tape MUST be provided by home to cover them up. Staff are not able to support in the removal of earrings.

Pupils are not allowed to wear long trousers for indoor PE as to avoid pupils tripping or slipping. If pupils do not have shorts available, trousers will be rolled up to the knees.

Pupils need to change into their PE shoes for each outdoor lesson as not all school shoes are suitable for PE. Therefore, to keep it consistent and fair for all pupils, school shoes are not to be worn.

Non participants:

Pupils who are excused from PE for medical reason will not be expected to physically take part in the lesson, instead they will be given other roles which are appropriate for their attire or ability. A child will be deemed able to do PE unless a member of staff has been informed differently by a parent/carer.

Spare kit will be lent to pupils who do not have their full kit in school as to ensure that all children are physical active during the lesson as far as possible. Please note that there is only a certain amount of spare kit and so it will be given out on a first come, first served basis. All spare kit is labelled so please ensure this is returned to school should it be taken home by mistake.

When does PE kit need to be in school?

All pupils must bring their PE kit into school on a Monday morning and take it home to be washed on a Friday regardless of their PE days. There are times when PE days are switched and therefore kit must be available each day. Teachers will check that all pupils have their kit on a Monday morning and parents/carers will be contacted and asked to bring them in if they are not present. The PE lead will also carry out spot checks through the course of the year to ensure that the correct kit is adhered to and in school.

If a pupil does not have their kit for 3 lessons, a letter will be sent home to parents/carers.

If anyone has any queries, please speak to the class teacher who will be happy to help.
