Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our ongoing strive for the best possible mathematics provision for your children, we have recently carried out a review of our curriculum spending and provision. We have concluded that our Mymaths online learning subscription is not supportive of our use of White Rose Education resources in school, nor is it providing best value for money. As such, the subscription has been cancelled so children will no longer be able to access this resource.

We are in the process of replacing this home learning provision with White Rose Education home learning books which revisit, reinforce and mirror the teaching and learning taking place in school. Moving forwards, once the new resources arrive, we will communicate to all Parents/Carers how we intend for these to be used and how you can best support your child at home.

Below are the names of a number of online resources that can be used to support your child's home learning and link to the topics they will cover in school.
