Dear Parent/Carer,

We have arranged for Thorpe Ventures, a sports coaching company based in Peterborough, to come to Norwood to deliver six, weekly cycling sessions for our students. The coached sessions will be on the following Mondays: 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th June, 7th and 14th July between 3:25-4:25pm.

Each session costs £3.25, making a total cost of £19.50 for the full six sessions. We ask that pupils commit to 6 sessions and that full payment is received in advance. Any non-attended sessions cannot be refunded.

There are 20 places available to children within any year group, and beginners to experienced cyclists are welcome to attend.

Thorpe Ventures will supply all the bikes and helmets required (although riders can bring their own bikes, and helmets, if they have two working brakes and gears). The sessions will be run on our school premises, either on the grass area or on the playground.

The activities are designed to improve the rider's ability and confidence as well as teaching them how to race like Olympic champions. The club is not about teaching children how to ride a bike. There is an emphasis on having fun and each session will also have a competitive element.

Please ensure that he or she has clothing suitable for an outdoor activity on the day and that they have a drink with them.

Children can be collected from the main playground at 4:25pm.
