Your child has been selected to represent Norwood School in the 2024 Peterborough STEM Festival Schools' Challenge Day at Anglia Ruskin University on **Monday 29th April 2024**. The day will comprise of a range of Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths challenges competing against other Primary Schools and is an excellent opportunity to celebrate these subjects and inspire a passion in children who have demonstrated high standards or aptitude in these areas.
