Dear Parents/Carers,

In our topic work post-Sats, Year 6 pupils will be exploring the topic of theme parks. All of our lessons will be linked to this theme including: designing their own theme park, using ICT and maths to calculate running costs, creating advertisements and recording radio ads in literacy and designing, building and painting their own ride booth in DT and art. This will all eventually lead to Year 6 organising and running Norwood School Summer Fair.

It is a fabulous topic with rich and exciting learning opportunities and as part of their learning we will be taking the children to Twin Lakes Theme Park near Melton Mowbray and travelling on a coach. This has been booked for **Wednesday 12th June 2024**. We will be leaving school at 9:15am and will be looking to return at 4.00pm, traffic permitting.

To cover the cost of this trip, including transport costs, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £24.00 per pupil, which has been subsidised £10.00, through funds raised through events at Norwood Primary School. **Payment will need to be paid on ParentPay and permission received via admin@norwoodschool.co.uk no later than Monday 3rd June 2024.** Pupils will also be able to get an ice lolly in the afternoon of the trip, before coming back to school. Although such a contribution is voluntary, should contributions received by school render the trip to be considered not viable, it will be cancelled and all contributions will be refunded.

However, in cases of financial hardship and particularly for our families in receipt of free school meals, we may be able to subsidise your contribution. Circumstances such as these will be treated sympathetically; do come and talk to me if this is the case – Mrs Reynolds (Head Teacher).

Pupils will need a packed lunch and their named water bottle. It is recommended that pupils bring their lunches in a plastic bag, meaning it can be thrown away once eaten. Children who are entitled to Free School Meals will have a packed lunch provided from the school kitchen, please click on the link below order you child their packed lunch for the trip. Please can this be completed by Monday 3rd June 2024 or it will be assumed that a packed lunch is being provided by home.
