As you are aware, Year 6 is the final year of your child's primary education and during this important year we are preparing the children for SATs that will be taken in May 2025 in the following 3 areas: Maths, Reading and GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling).

In previous years, the school has provided books for parents/carers to purchase, at a discounted price. 'Rising Stars' *Practice Questions, Revision Guide* and *Practice Papers* are available in the subjects of **Reading, GPS** and **Maths**. In the past, these books have been very successful for pupils in Year 6.

These books are in line with the current curriculum, assessments procedures, and higher expectation for this Year 6 cohort of children. I recommend to parents/carers that there are many revision aids on the internet and any work completed will be beneficial as a "top up".

I believe these books will serve as both an excellent revision aid for your child and you, as parents/carers will also have a clearer understanding of the requirements for children to achieve the appropriate level.

To purchase an individual book, the cost will be £5.99 per book.

School can also bulk order in batches of 10 books at a cost of £26.00 per bundle.
